- *Denim is acceptable casual attire*
- *Hamilton Club members – and their guests – are expected to be neatly adorned.*
- *Casual attire, to include denim, is acceptable in all Hamilton Club restaurants.*
- *Club Functions will be assigned specific dress codes.*
- *Managers determine the meaning of “neatly adorned.” For example: some sandals may appear to be flip-flops. Sandals are neat; flip-flops are not. Given the range of acceptable dress in the 21st Century, it is impossible to compose exhaustive lists defining “neat” and “sloppy.” If you are concerned about the appearance of your fellow member, direct your concern to a manager.*

These standards, along with the following additional information, are applicable depending on venue and function and are expressed as guidelines, except those identified as “unacceptable.”

Children over the age of 12 are expected to adhere to the dress code.

***Semi-formal or Business Attire***

When an event is designated as ***Semi-formal*** or ***Business Attire***, Gentlemen are requested to wear a business suit or sport jacket and trousers with collared shirt and/or necktie. Ladies may wear professional/ social attire including suits, dress slacks, skirts and dresses. Clergy or members of the Armed Forces may wear the commensurate uniform.

***Business Casual***

When an event is designated as ***Business Casual***, Gentlemen are requested to wear a collared or turtleneck shirt with tailored trousers. Ladies attire should be professional/ social commensurate. Business Casual is the minimum standard of dress in the clubhouse outside of the health club facilities, unless otherwise specified.

***Denim***

Denim is acceptable attire in any of the Club's restaurants and is acceptable at events whose designated dress code is business casual or casual.

***Summer Casual***

For the Buchanan and Tower Bars from Memorial Day through Labor Day, Casual dress applies with the addition of Bermuda Shorts in the Tower Bar and Lounge as well as the Buchanan Bar on weekends. Please remember that this style does not apply to the Steinman Room.

***Unacceptable Attire***

Under no circumstances are tank tops, tee shirts, halter tops, shorts, baseball caps, athletic shoes, sweat pants, beach clothes, exposed undergarments, tops exposing a bare midriff or any other very casual clothes permitted in any area of the club other than as appropriate for the Health Club facilities.
